Collaborative Specialization (CP) Definition: "an intra-university graduate field of study that provides an additional multidisciplinary experience for students enrolled in and completing the degree requirements of one of a number of approved masters and/or PhD programs. Students meet the admission requirements of and register in the participating (or 'home') program but complete, in addition to the degree requirements of that program, the additional requirements specified by the Collaborative Specialization. The degree conferred is that of the home program. The completion of the Collaborative Specialization is indicated by a transcript notation indicating the additional specialization." (QAF)

The learning outcomes of a collaborative specialization are in addition to those supported by the home program.

The collaborative specialization appears to have had modest but consistent student interest, with enrolments ranging between 9 and 18 students over each of the past 10 years. Student completions pose more of a concern, with only 6 students completing the requirements during that time period. This issue of student completions was raised in the 2008 review. The previous review also queried whether students would have difficulty completing the collaborative specialization requirements given that the MST1111 course was not offered every year. Since the previous review, this course has not in fact been offered on a regular basis.	This collaborative specialization is currently experiencing challenges both in student completions and in attracting interest from diverse disciplines. The Director's proposed curriculum changes are expected to increase student interest and improve completion rates. At the same time, it will be crucial for the collaborative specialization committee to continue to encourage associated units to re-engage to ensure that the collaborative specialization is truly collaborative specialization continues to draw students only from CMS, it is recommended that collaborative specialization closure be considered and that a new concentration in editing medieval texts be developed within the graduate programs in Medieval Studies.
