Closure of a program	The decision to close the program is a result of the 2012-13 UTQAP review of the Human Biology programs. The program was initially launched to reflect interest in the field but student demand never materialized. As part of curricular renewal, the academic content in the Health Care Ethics Major 300-level bioethics course was realigned to suit a wider audience of life science students. Closure of a program	Closure of the program was discussed and endorsed through the 2015-16 UTQAP review of the Department of Cell and Systems Biology and its programs. The program is closing due to a lack of student interest in the program. The academic content will continue to be taught through the recently created Stem Cells and Developmental Biology focus option within the Cell and Molecular Biology Specialist and Major programs.
